1. WHAT IS A COOKIE?

A cookie is a file that is downloaded on your device (computer or mobile device) when accessing certain webs or apps in order to store information which can be updated and retrieved by the entity responsible of its installation.

2. WHAT TYPE OF COOKIES DOES OUR WEBSITE USE?

Below, we provide information about the type of cookies used on our websites:

2.1. Depending on the entity that manages the cookies:

According to the entity that manages the domain from which the cookies are sent and treat the data obtained, we can distinguish:

- **Own cookies:** Are those sent to the user's terminal equipment from domains managed by Salto Systems as editor of the website.
- **Third-party cookies:** Are those that are sent to the user's terminal equipment from a computer or domain that is not managed by the publisher, but by another entity.

2.2. Depending on the time they remain active in the terminal equipment:

- › **Session Cookies:** These are a type of cookies designed to collect and store data while the user enters the website. As its name says, these cookies are stored in your terminal until the end of the user's browsing session.
- › **Persistent cookies:** They are a type of cookies in which the data is still stored in the terminal and can be accessed and treated during a period defined by the person responsible for the cookie, which can go from a few minutes to a maximum of two years from its installation.

2.3. According to its purpose:

- › **Strictly necessary cookies:** These are those that allow the user to navigate through the website and use the different options or services that are available such as, for example, controlling traffic and data communication, identifying the type of browser, identifying the session, accessing restricted access areas, using the services made available to the user, using security elements during navigation, identifying user preferences or sharing content through social networks. These types of cookies improve the user's experience by optimizing performance based on the information collected. SALTO does not need your consent for the installation of these cookies on your device.
- › **Targeting cookies:** Are those that allow the management of the advertising spaces included in the website in the most efficient way. These cookies store information on users' behavior obtained through continuous monitoring of their browsing habits, which allows the creation of a specific profile to display advertising based on it. These cookies are only installed on your device with your express consent.
- › **Performance cookies:** These cookies are designed and used for tracking and analyzing user behavior. This type of cookies offer the owner of the page the measurement of activity on the website through aggregated information or statistics. These cookies are only installed on your device with your express consent.
- › **Functional cookies:** These cookies permit to remember information so that the user accesses the service with certain characteristics that can distinguish his experience from other users, such as, for example, the language, the number of results to be shown when the user makes a search, the aspect or content of the service depending on the type of browser through which the user accesses or the region from which the user accesses the service, etc. These cookies are only installed on your device with your express consent.

3. HOW DO YOU GIVE YOUR CONSENT?
